to William Roe being proven before John Shonar Justice  
Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Walker was presented and Recorded  
this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1799

This Indenture made the sixth day of August in the year of  
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight  
between William Whaley late of Greenville County in  
the State of South Carolina of the one part and William Roe  
of the State & County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth  
that the said William Whaley for and In consideration  
of the sum of one hundred Dollars to him in hand well & truly  
paid by the said William Roe at and before the sealing &  
Delivery hereof, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
hath granted, bargained, sold, alined, conveyed, & confirmed,  
and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell, aline release  
Convey and Confirm unto the said William Roe all those less  
tracts or parcels of Land containing by estimation Seventy  
eight acres more or less, in Greenville County aforesaid on the  
South side of the South fork of Tygar River being part

of three hundred acres granted to Alexander Ray on the 15<sup>th</sup> day  
of October in the year 1784 and part of Nineteen acres granted  
to the said Alexander Ray on the second day of February in  
the year 1789 which said seventy acres, and eight acres  
was conveyed by said Alexander Ray to the said William Whaley  
by Indentures bearing date on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December  
1793 and on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1794 reference  
being had unto the Grants & Conveyances will more  
plainly fully appear and in the possession of the said  
William Roe now being by virtue of a Bargain &  
Sale to him thereof made by said William Whaley  
Together with all & singular the houses Barns buildings  
privileges premises and appertinences thereto belong-  
ing or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the  
said Seventy eight acres of Land more or less unto the  
said William Roe his Heirs and aspirgs forever, and aga-  
inst him the said William Whaley his Heirs Executors  
and Administrators and against every other person &  
persons will warrant and for ever defend by these
