Garrison being proven before Ambus Blackburn Esq: by  
the oaths of Thompson Dukerson was presented and Recorded  
this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 1799 -  
The State of South Carolina Know all men by these  
presents that I John Ware of the County of Greenville  
and State aforesaid in Consideration of the sum of one  
hundred and fifty pounds Sterling to me paid by David  
Garrison of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid  
have Granted bargained sold and released and by these  
presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto David  
Garrison all that tract of land lying in Greenville County  
on the Golden Grove Creek containing by a Survey Two hundred  
and sixty seven acres beginning on said creek on land granted  
to Ambrose Blackburn and running N.E. 45° 16' 56" to a  
Hickory corner thence S.E. 30° 18' on said of Blackburn's  
line to a white oak thence S.E. 75° 20' to a pine corner thence  
S.E. 40° 39' to a stake corner on Thompson Dukerson's  
land, thence S.E. 45° 25' to a branch which was made a con-  
ditional line between John and Samuel Ware thence down  
said branch unto its confluence with the little Grove Creek  
a branch of the Golden Grove Creek from thence down said  
creek until it comes to John Bowes line Land whereon  
Scott and his son now lives from thence N.W. 47° 19' to  
the corner of said Bowes land from thence N.W. 40° 39'  
to the Golden Grove Creek from thence up said creek where it  
passes between Philip Evans and the land now described  
unto the Beginning corner which said above described land  
is part of three original Grants a part of which Granted to

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Meredith Blackburn a part Granted to James Bradley and  
a part Granted to Nathaniel Head Reference being had with  
more fully appear and which above described land is now  
sold and conveyed by John Ware unto David Garrison  
together with all and singular the members hereditaments  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said David Garrison his heirs and assigns forever and  
I do here hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and sin-  
gular the said premises unto the said David Garrison his  
Heirs and assigns against myself my heirs assigns  
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to whom  
the same or any part hereof witness my hand and  
seal this fourth day of November in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty seven  
and in the Seventy second Year of the Sovereignty and  
Independency of the United States of America.
