This Indenture made this 11<sup>th</sup> day of February in the  
year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and  
ninety nine between John Byas Blackwell of Greenville  
County & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina of the one part and David  
Noris of the same County & State aforesaid of the other  
part witnesseth that the said John B. Blackwell for  
in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred  
Dollars to him in hand paid by David Noris the receipt  
whereof the said Blackwell doth here by acknowledge hath  
Granted Bargained & sold unto the said David Noris his heirs  
& assigns forever one certain tract or part of Land situate  
lying & being in the County of Greenville on the North side  
of one of the prongs of Reddy River containing one hundred acres  
more or less being part of a tract Granted to the said John B  
Blackwell bearing date 1796 and bounded as follows (to wit)  
beginning at the corner Frederick Shuchins line thence  
west to a Red oak corner thence E to a stake thence S<sup>o</sup> to the  
Creek thence down the Creek to the Beginning To have and  
to hold the above sold Land & premises with all and singular  
the premises legges & appertinances thereof unto him the said  
David Noris his heirs & assigns forever with every part or parcel  
thereof to him the said David Noris his heirs & assigns forever

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against him the said John Byas Blackwell or his heirs and  
against the Lawfull claim and demand of any other person  
or persons what so ever shall do I will warrant & forward and  
the rates of said Land to the said Noris his heirs or assigns as  
witness whereof the said John Byas Blackwell hath here  
unto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and date first  
above written signed Sealed & acknowledged in presence of  
Joseph Glover James <sup>his</sup> Young

Samuel Moor being proven before Robert Cook Esq<sup>r</sup> of the  
oath of Isaac Cox was presented and recorded this 2<sup>d</sup> of 1799  
State of South Carolina Now all men by these presents  
that Elizabeth Medop of the County of Greenville and  
and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one  
hundred Dollars to me paid by Samuel Moor of the County  
by and State aforesaid have Granted bargained and  
by these presents do Grant bargain sell and Release  
unto the said Samuel Moor all that plantation or tract  
of one hundred acres of Land more or less originally granted  
to James Scaborn and signed by his Excellency Thomas  
Pinkney the fifth day of January in the year of our Lord  
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty nine situate  
in Greenville County on both sides of Stony Creek bounded  
on the South west on the South East and on the North  
East by the said Thomas Longs Land and on the North  
west on vacant Land being laid out unto the said  
Samuel Moor as follows Beginning on a black oak  
corner and south S<sup>o</sup> E. 114 chains to a stake corner from  
thence Running N. 60 E. 2.0 to a red oak from thence  
Running N. 40. W. 40 to a pine corner and from thence to
