The following deed of conveyance from Charles Hulsey to  
 Senens Hulsey being given before Thomas Campbell Esq. by the oath  
 of A. Hulsey was presented and recorded this 27 day of April 1799  
 This Indenture made this twelfth day of September in  
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
 ninety eight between Charles Hulsey sen<sup>r</sup> of the State  
 of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part  
 and Senens Hulsey of the S<sup>d</sup> State and County of  
 the other part, Witnesseth that the S<sup>d</sup> Charles Hulsey for  
 an Consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds  
 Sterling money to him in hand paid by Senens  
 Hulsey before the sealing of these presents the receipt  
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge he hath Bargain-  
 ed and sold and by these presents doth Bargain and  
 sell and confirm unto Senens Hulsey his heirs  
 and assigns forever all that plantation or tract of Land

Containing one hundred and forty seven acres &c. the same more  
 or less Situate in the County aforesaid on the waters of  
 Line Creek beginning at a Red oak & X Corner on the S. W.  
 line of the Survey originally Granted to Charles Saper  
 the other being part of a tract of Land originally Granted  
 to Samuel Neighbors of five hundred and nine by  
 six acres and also all the Lands trees timbers trees woods  
 by the Commons of pastures ways waters and water  
 courses and appurtenances what soever to the same  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the  
 Rents and services of the said premises and every  
 part and parcel thereof and all the Estate Right Titles  
 Interest and Claims of what so ever of them the said  
 Charles Hulsey of in and to the S<sup>d</sup> premises and every part  
 thereof to have and to hold the said tract of premises more  
 or less and all and singular the premises above mentioned  
 with the appurtenances unto the said Senens Hulsey his  
 heirs and assigns for ever and the said Charles Hulsey  
 for himself and his heirs the said tract of 147 acres of  
 Land more or less and premises and every part thereof  
 against him and his heirs and assigns and against all  
 and every other person or persons whatsoever will warrant  
 and forever defend to the S<sup>d</sup> Senens Hulsey his heirs and
