

232 The following Bill of sale from James Sarant to John Charles being proven before Ambrose Blackburn Esq. by the oath of James Sarants was presented and recorded this 11th day of June 1799
 Now all men by these presents that James Sarant of Granville County State of South Carolina by virtue of a power of an attorney for that purpose made the 29th of December 1797 by Josiah Slemmacy hath bargained sold and delivered unto John Charles for the consideration of three hundred & five Dollars to me in hand paid one Negro woman named Alice & by virtue of said powers warrant & defend the Negro to the said John Charles & his heirs against any person or persons forever Witness my hand & seal this 11th of January 1799

232 The following deed of conveyance from John Rodgers to John Cunningham being proven before David Goodlette Esq. by the oath of Moses Sings was presented and recorded this 11th day of June 1799
 The State of South Carolina
 Now all men by these presents that John Rodgers of Granville County and State aforesaid in consideration of one Hundred Dollars to me paid by John Cunningham of the County & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Cunningham all that Measure tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the State and County aforesaid containing forty acres more or less the same being part of a tract of Land originally granted unto John Sadberry on the 6th day of October 1788 and sold by him unto the said John Cunningham as follows (viz) Beginning

233 on a black oak St from thence to a Hyion on the original line St from thence to an ash corner in the branch St thence down the main doers of the branch to the fork on D yals line, from thence to a post oak corner thence along the original line to the beginning, Together with all and singular rights & manors hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Cunningham his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by giving myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Cunningham his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this 11th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and in the twenty third year of the independence of the united States of America
