
The following Receipt from De Burke to Elijah Walker  
being proven before David Goodette Esq by the oath of  
John Blasingame Esq<sup>r</sup> was presented and recorded this  
10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1799

Pickensville 13 April 1799 where as Elijah Walker  
of the Golden Grove gave me two notes of hand bearing  
date 1797 Each note for the said was he was paying me  
150 Dollars both together three Hundred Dollars which  
money he was to pay me on my making him Titled to  
a tract of Land which he rented of me; and where as  
I have ~~paid~~ executed to him the said Titled and he has  
said me the said Three Hundred Dollars with interest  
now know all men that the said notes have mislaid  
in Charles Town so that I cannot find them before I left  
Town but I shew by promise to bear the said Walker  
his Executors & Administrators harm less and secure  
against the said notes or any one of them & for this purpose  
I bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators  
by these presents Given under my hand and seal

263 The following deed of Conveyance from John Hinton to  
Middletown Prayton being proven before George Salmon Esq<sup>r</sup>  
by the oath of Bary West was presented and recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> of June 1799  
this Deed made the Twenty fourth day of December  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight  
Between John Hinton of Laurens County and State of South  
Carolina of the one part and Middletown Prayton of Granville  
County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that  
the said John Hinton for and in consideration of the sum of Five  
Pounds Sterling money to him the said John Hinton  
in hand paid the Receipt whereof doth he by such now do  
with Grant Bargain and sold Confessed and confirmed &  
by these presents do Grant bargain sell Confessed and  
confirm unto the said Middletown Prayton his Heirs and  
all that Tract or parcel of Land containing one Hundred  
Situate lying and being on the south west side of the North  
fork of Saluda River in Granville County aforesaid  
Relation being there unto had may more fully appear and is  
Bounded as followeth  Beginning at a stake on the west  
side of the North fork of Saluda River on Salmons line  
thence S 77 N 9 6 chain to a post oak Salmons corner thence  
S 36 50 to a post oak on Salmons line thence N 77 E  
63 00 to and oak thence N 22 E 30 00 to a Light wood  
Stump thence a S E course a Conditona marked line to  
an old path thence along S<sup>d</sup> path to the wagon Road thence  
with said Road to a post oak 23 chain thence N 36 E to the  
head of a branch thence a down S<sup>d</sup> branch to the River thence  
to the beginning Together with all Houses Buildings or Charn  
gardens in provement trees woods under woods waters water  
courses profits Commodities Incidents and appurtenances  
whatsoever to the same in any wise appertaining
