This Indenture made this Nineteenth day of December  
In the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and  
Ninety Eight between Thomas McGrew of Greenville  
County and State of South Carolina of the one part and  
Mapes Aresmith of the County and State aforesaid of the  
other part witnesseth that the said Thomas McGrew for  
and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to  
him in hand paid the Receipt and payment whereof he

269 doth hereby acknowledging hath given Granted and sold and by these  
presents doth Give Grant Sell and confirm unto the said Mapes  
Aresmith a certain plantation or tract of Land containing  
one hundred and thirty eight acres it being Granted to him  
the said Thomas McGrew from States Office bearing date  
Sixth of April One thousand seven hundred and eighty nine  
lying and being in the County aforesaid situation on the waters  
of the South fork of Tygar river beginning on black oak  
running S 45 W 7. 50 to a post oak S 26 W 30 to a red  
oak thence N 50 E 19 to a white oak thence south 60. E. 46.  
00 to a stake thence S 40 W 2. 5- 50 thence S 30 E. 40 00 to the  
beginning together with all woods waters minus minerals  
tenements and appurtenances to the said land belonging

Davis being proven before Rubin Barretto Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John  
Davidson was presented and Recorded this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1799  
This Indenture made this first day of May in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety four between John  
Davidson of Greenville County and state of South Carolina
