The following deed of Conveyance from Asaham Burkes
to Richard Brasil being proven before Willy Brown Esq;
by the oath of David Hall was presented and Recorded this
14th day of June 1799

State of South Carolina Newall man by these presents
that Asaham Burkes of Greenville County in considera-
tion of the sum of Fifty Pounds to me paid by Richard
Brasil of the County aforesaid have Granted Bargained
sold & released and by these presents do Grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Richard Brasil a plantation
or tract of Land lying & being in the County aforesaid
on S^co. Salatate River Beginning at a tall oak in the fork
of the River & Green's Creek about one chain from the river
Willy S. Brown's bottom running thence S^co 20 W.
of the River to a post oak then to a pine on David Hall's
Land thence S^co 10 W. N^c 60 E. 450 Links to a pine thence
N^c 60 W. N^c 60 E. to a chestnut Oak thence N^c 10 W.
19 Link to a River to a tall oak thence N^c 60 E. to
Willy S. Brown's line to a Stake thence S^co 39 E. to a
Red oak thence S^co 2 E. 15 Link to a Black oak thence
S^co 39 E. to the beginning containing by estimation
one hundred acres of the same more or less being part
of a tract Granted by patent to Joseph Maxwell bearing
date 5th December 1791 and by him conveyed to Mr. Huddleston
by him conveyed William Laughlin and John Husson

Lying there to me on said tract is a slave who is entitled
a full mill together with all and singular the Rights now
and heretofore belonging to the said premises be-
longing or in any wise appertaining thereto and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Richard Brasil his heirs & assigns forever & to hereby bind
myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto
the said Richard Brasil his Heirs & assigns against
myself and my heirs & against every person wheresoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal This Twenty first day of April in the year
of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty
Eight and Twenty second year of American indepen-

The following deed of Conveyance from John Davidson to
William Wood being proven before Rubin Barret Esq; by
the oath of Alexander Anderson was presented and Recorded
this 14th day of June 1799.

This indenture made this first day of May in the year of
our Lord Anno Domini one thousand and Sixty four between
John Davidson of Greenville and state of S^c Carolina of
the one the one part and William Wood in the County and
State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Ten pounds to him in hand paid by
said William Wood before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt hereof is hereby fully acknowledged
Bargain'd and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell All his release confirm, and convey unto the
