County have granted Bargained sold & released and
by these presents do Grant Bargain sell Release unto
the said Isham Burkes a plantation or tract of Land
saying and being in Greenville County on S^o pacotah River
Beginning at a Red oak in the fork of the River and
Greens Creek about One Chain from the River Willey
S Browns corner running thence S^o 30^W 13^{ft} to a
post Oak thence to a pine on David Hales Land thence E^o
16^{ft} W^o 11^{ft} chain 50 Links to a pine thence S^o 60^W 17^{ft} chain
back next oak thence E^o 10^{ft} W^o 19^{ft} chain to B the River
to a Red oak thence E^o 60^{ft} to Willey S. Browns line
to a Stake thence S^o 39^{ft} E^o to a Red oak thence S^o 38^{ft}
15^{ft} chain to a Black Oak thence S^o 39^{ft} E^o to the Beginning
containing by Estimation one hundred acres but the same
more or less being part of tract granted by patent to
Joseph Maxwell bearing date 6th December 1779 and
by him conveyed to John Huddleston and by him to us on said
