 of at their own will when and how they themselves most prefer in

98 The following deed of conveyance from Pinckney Holcombe to
 William Wood being from his son Rubin Barrett Esq^r by the death of Eliza -
 stan Holcombe was presented and Recorded this 12th day of July 1799
 This instrument made this twenty seventh day of February one
 thousand seven hundred and ninety nine between Pinckney Hol-
 combe of the state of S Carolina and County of Greenville under
 William Wood of the state and County aforesaid witnesseth that the said
 Pinckney Holcombe for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
 Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said William Wood the
 receipt whereof is here by acknowledged hath granted bargained and
 sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell a certain tract
 of land and convey and confirm unto the said William Wood and his Heirs and
 assigns forever all that Plantation or tract of land containing
 sixty one acres more or less being granted to the said Pinckney
 Holcombe by His Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq^r Governor and
 Commander in chief in and over the said State at Columbia the
 seventh day of Nov^r 1791 situated lying and being in the state
 of Carolina aforesaid on both sides of Bartons fork of S^r Sugar River
 bounded by a line running S^r W^r Andersons Land A C^r Davis
 Davis Land the other sides by Vacant Land together with every
 appurtenance belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said
 tract of land hereditaments and premises aforesaid mentioned and
 every part thereof unto the said William Wood His Heirs and assigns
 forever and the said Pinckney Holcombe doth covenant and bind with the

said William Wood His Heirs and assigns from and against all persons claim-
 ing to claim the said premises shall and will warrant and by these
 presents forever defend In witness whereof the said parties have here
 unto set their hands and seals

The following deed of convey from Moses Kemp to John Rodgers being
 proven before Robert Mafie Esq^r by the oath of Abram Hudson was
 presented and Recorded this 22nd day of July 1799

This instrument made this the 27th day of November in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the
 twentieth year of the Independence of the United States of America
 between Moses Kemp of Greenville County and State of Carolina
 of the one part and John Rodgers of the said County and State
 of the other part witnesseth for and in consideration of
 the sum of sum of Sixty five pounds in hand paid by John Rodgers
 Hath Bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and
 make over unto John Rodgers a certain Plantation or tract of
 Land containing six hundred and sixteen Acres lying in Greenville
 County on Rocky Creek the waters of the Broad River and on the
 Branches of Laurel Creek of Reedy River and hath such boundaries
 wheras it begin in a corner Hickory Corner Running thence N.
 40 E. 80 ch to a post Oak corner there N 30 W 77 ch to a Red Oak
 Corner thence S 40 W 80 ch to a black Jack corner thence E. 50. b.
 77 ch to the beginning it being a tract of Land granted unto John
 Connor from under the Hand of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney
 Esq^r bearing date one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight
 Recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court page 258
 The said John Connor hath Granted bargained and sold the above
 described tract of Land unto Moses Kemp and he the above men-
 tioned Moses Kemp hath Granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said John Rodgers
 the above described tract of Land containing six hundred and
 sixteen acres together with the woods waters hereditaments
 and appurtenances unto said land belonging or in any wise appur-
 taining thereto and the same to remain as remainder Rents
 dues and profits thereof to have and to hold the granted premises
 of the above mentioned tract of land unto the said John Rodgers
