



Greenville County in the State of South Carolina in consideration of one hundred Dollars to me in hand by Francis Brown Jun^r of the State and County aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said Francis Brown all that plantation or tract of Land containing sixty five acres (the same more or less) situate in Greenville County aforesaid lying on the Branch of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River Beginning on a white Oak 3/4 of a Branch thence up the Meanders of said Branch S. 75 W. to a Turkey Oak 3/4 23-30 thence S. 5 W. to a Dogwood 3/4 9 thence S. 35 E. to a Stake 3/4 7-30 thence S. 5 W. 28 chains to a Stake 3/4 thence S. 20 E. 19 chains to the Beginning.

Together with all and singular the Rights and Members Appurtenances and appertinances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Francis Brown his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Francis Brown his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the first day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the twenty fourth year of the independence of the United States of America. The following deed of Conveyance from David Ridgway to James Mullins being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq^r by the oath of James Holland was presented and recorded this 13th day of August 1799 This Indenture made the 30th day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight between David Ridgway of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of one part and James Mullins of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Ridgway for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five Dollars to him in hand paid by the said James Mullins at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said David

Ridgway doth hereby acknowledge and to be well contented satisfied and paid have Granted bargained sold and confirmed and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell and alien Convey Convey and Confirm unto the said James Mullins a Certain tract of Land containing sixty one acres more or less lying in Washington District State and County aforesaid on Horse Creek of Reedy River lying William Annots Land on the Antient Boundary of Wm Henry Burrow N. W. on Benjamin Annots S. E. and Thomas Capin Together with all and singular houses building Rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to, with the said tract of sixty one acres of Land with the Reversions and Reversion Remainders and Remainders Rents uses & profits thereof unto the said James Mullins his heirs Executors and administrators and assigns to have and to hold the said tract of Land with its premises and appurtenances unto the said James Mullins his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Mullins his heirs and assigns forever and the said David Ridgway doth for himself his heirs &c. forever defend from him for ever witness whereof the said David Ridgway hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presents of Henry Burrow & James Holland David Ridgway 

The following deed of Conveyance from William Turpin to Thomas Wadsworth being proven before James Boyer Esq^r of Laurens County was presented and Recorded this 14th day of August 1799 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I William Turpin Merchant State aforesaid for and in consideration of the same value in land conveyed to me by Thomas Wadsworth have Granted released and conveyed unto the said Thomas Wadsworth all my right to the following tracts of land they having fallen to him in a division of certain tracts of land which were held jointly by Thomas Wadsworth and William Turpin Viz, laying and being situate in Greenville County Washington District one Tract of Land containing four hundred and eighty acres surveyed for William King & May the sixteenth one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five and by him conveyed to Wadsworth & Turpin the twenty sixth & twenty seventh days of March
