


340 Deed of Sale by William Austin on the sixth day of October in the year of 1786
situate in the district of Ninety Six on the waters of Gilders Creek
on the south side of Grays Branch bounding on Amos Richardson's
land beginning at a pine corner running East to stake the original
corner from thence N^E to Grays Branch & Crop Grays Branch in
cluding a spring head on the North side of S^E Branch thence to
said Branch & corner on said Branch from thence a S^W to the
mouth of a spring Branch Bounding on Amos Richardson's
Lane from thence a south course on the conventional line between S^E
Richardson's and Hollon to the beginning corner including one
hundred and thirty acres or there more or less. Together with all
and singular the houses and houses ways waters paths passages
fences easements hereditaments and appurtenances what so ever
to the parcel of Land so described belonging or in any wise appur-
taining and the Reversion & Reversions, Remainder, and Remainders,
Rents, issues and profits thereof, and every part and parcel thereof,
and all the State right to all interest claim demand what so ever
both in law and equity of the said William Austin of it and to the
said premises and of it, and to every part and parcel thereof of the
said to have and to hold the said parcel of Land and all and singular
the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the S^E Solomon
Hollon his heirs and assigns to the only paper used and behoof
of the said Solomon Hollon his Heirs and assigns forever & lastly
the said William Austin for himself his Heirs the S^E 1030 of Land
more or less and all the singular premises above Granted with their
appurtenances to the said Solomon Hollon & his Heirs and assigns against
all persons what so ever shall and will warrant & forever defend in
witness whereof William Austin hath set his hand and seal the
22nd day of August in the year above written.



341 The following deed of Conveyance from Nathaniel Harbin to Henry
Reins being proven before Robert Walker Esq^r by the oath of Samuel
Harbin was presented and recorded this 6th day of September 1799
This Indenture made this sixth day of February in the year of
our Lord Anno thousand one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight
and of the independence of the United States the Twenty third between
Nath Harbin of the State of Carolina & County of Greenville of the
one Part & Henry Reins of the County & State aforesaid of the other
part witnesseth for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Pounds
sterling lawful money of S^t State in hand paid by Henry Reins
to Nath Harbin and sold & by these presents doth Bargain and sell
& make over unto S^r Henry Reins a certain Plantation or tract
of Land containing fifty acres more or less lying in Greenville
County on the Branches of Brushy Creek or Coopers River and
an hath such boundaries whereas it Beginning at a Branch
running through John Reinses lot to a State corner thence up
S^E Branch to the head at a state corner then a straight course to a
Bullars old corner Red Oak thence to Champs corner Post Oak thence
a straight course to Nat Harbins line on a state corner By the head
of the Mill Branch thence to the Beginning it being a part of a tract
containing four hundred and twenty six acres granted unto iron
Kings from under the hand of his Excellency Arnoldus Vandebest
bearing date the fifth day of January One Thousand seven hundred
ninety five Recorded Book D. v. 5 page 46 he hath granted
to & sold & by these presents with bargain sell & convey unto the sd Henry
Reins the above described tract of land containing fifty acres
more or less together with the waters hereditaments and appurtenances
unto the S^E land belonging or in any wise appertaining & executors
and Revisions Remainder and Remainders unto his heirs and people
