a certain Tract of Land Situate lying and being in Greenville  
County Washington District on the waters of Reedy River lying near  
the said River Containing Three hundred and Sixty acres bounded  
on a stake S. E. 66<sup>o</sup> 44' chains to a stake thence S. W. 2<sup>o</sup> 44' 60' chains  
located back thence S. W. 66<sup>o</sup> 44' chains to a stake thence S. E. 2<sup>o</sup>  
to the first station being the one half of a tract of Land of Sixty Acres  
and Forty acres Granted originally to Henry Sommory and so to by an  
act of assembly for the non payment of the Bounty. Together with all  
and singular the trees waters hereditaments & its members and appurte-

and ninety eight Between Charles Sowell & Richard Sowell of Greenville  
County in the state of S<sup>t</sup> Carolina of the one part and Rubbin Smith of  
the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said  
Charles Sowell & Richard Sowell for and in consideration of the sum of three  
hundred and Twenty Dollars to him in hand paid at said Rubbin Smith  
before sealing Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged hath Granted Bargained sold Alene Released & confirmed  
and by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell Alene Release & confirm  
unto the said Rubbin Smith all that tract plantation and parcel of  
Land Situate on Bush Creek a Branch of Conewee river including the plan-  
tation on which the said Charles Sowell now lives containing eighty acres which  
is tract a parcel of Land was Originally granted to Michael Johnston by Captain Gant  
bearing date bearing date the first day of October in the year of our Lord  
One Thousand seven hundred and Eighty Seven under the hand of his Excellency  
Thomas Pinckney Esq<sup>t</sup> then Governor of the said State and the Great Seal  
of the state aforesaid for that purpose appurtenant being there unto affixed  
which said Grant is duly record in the Secretarys Office of S<sup>t</sup> State rebus  
there unto being there unto had will more fully appear and also the said eighty  
acres was granted by said Michael Johnston unto Am<sup>t</sup> Kemp by an Indenture  
date the twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand  
seven hundred and Eighty Eight returning there unto will also appear  
now by the sd Am<sup>t</sup> Kemp by these presents unto the said Charles Sowell  
by Jordan this bearing date the nineteenth of October in the year of our Lord  
one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Three returning there unto had will  
more appear and by the sd Charles Sowell Richard Sowell by these presents  
unto the said Rubbin Smith eighty acres lying on both sides of Bush  
Creek running Benjamin Walker Below together with all and singu-  
lar the houses and houses Barns Stables buildings yards gardens orchards  
woods under woods pastures ponds projects hereditaments and appurtenances  
unto to said eighty acres of Land Belonging in any wise appertaining and  
Reversion and Reversions remainder and remainders Rents issues and profits  
thereof and of every part parcel thereof to have and to hold the said above granted  
Land with all and every the premises and appurtenances thereof unto the said  
Rubbin Smith his Heirs and assigns forever and S<sup>t</sup> Charles Sowell and Richard
