South Carolina This Indenture made the _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine and in the Twenty first year of American Independence between William Gambler of the County of Greenville and State of said of the One part and William Cull of said County and State of the Other part Witnesseth the said Gambler in consideration of the sum of ten pounds to him in hand paid by the said William Cull before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Gambler doth acknowledge and thereof and from Every part and parcel thereof doth acquit and discharge the said William Cull his heirs and assigns and for divers other good Causes and Consideration then unto moving have Granted Bargained sold alien Enjoined and confirmed and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell alien Enjoined and confirm unto the said Cull his heirs and assigns forever part of certain tract of Land containing two hundred and thirty one acres Originally Granted to the said Gambler and signed by his Executor William Northrie on the Twenty fifth day of November 1794 situate in Greenville County on the south side of Guilford Creek of Enora River Beginning
