self his heirs & executors Administrators & assigns or any other person  
or persons whatsoever in any Just or Lawful Right Little  
or None there unto or any part thereof but to the only proper

use or behoof of him the s<sup>d</sup> William God Smith his heirs executors  
Administrators and assigns forever Witness whereof the said John  
Williams hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and  
date first above written his

The Following deed of Conveyance from James Kelley To John Chapman  
being proven before Joseph Franklin Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Andrew  
Tallent was presented and acknowledged this 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1799

### The State of South Carolina

Know all men by these presents that James Kelley of Greenville  
County in the state aforesaid In consideration of Two hundred  
and six dollars to me in hand paid by John Chapman of the  
State and County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and  
Released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and Release  
and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the  
said John Chapman a tract of Land Containing One hundred  
and Three acres (both samemore or less) situated in the County  
aforesaid lying on Rocky River Beginning on a beach 3x on said  
River running thence East 25' 10' E<sup>o</sup> to a tree Kelly's line  
to a Rock 3x thence North 17' 40' On Solomon King Chanc-  
lers line to a Red Oak 3x thence West 60 chains to a beach on Rocky  
River thence down the meanders of S<sup>o</sup> River to the beginning of being  
part of a Tract of Six hundred and Forty acres of Land Originally  
Granted to John Wilson on the sixteenth day of July 1784 the  
said Grant Recorded in Grant book a<sup>c</sup>t 4. S. A. page 57.

Together with all and singular the Rights and members Heredi-  
taments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging as in any  
wise incident appertaining. I have and to hold all and  
singular the premises aforesaid mentioned unto the said John  
Chapman his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant to  
and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said John Chapman his heirs and assigns against my  
self and my heirs and against every other person whom so-  
ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
