Know all men by these presents that James Daniel of the State of South Carolina county six district am held and firmly bound unto Benjamin Hilgore of the state and district aforesaid in the full sum of five hundred pounds Sterling to which payment well and truly to me made I bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators unto the said Benjamin Hilgore his heirs heirs or assigns firmly by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this the eighth day of January One thousand seven hundred and eight five and in the sixth year of American Independence

The Conditions of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound James Daniel his heirs or Executors or Administrators do well & truly make unto the said Benjamin Hilgore a lawful Right and title to a tract of Land of four hundred acres the the same being by Virtue of a warrant from under the hand and seal of John Thomas Committed one of Locations. So Saluda Granted unto the said James Daniel bearing date the nineteenth day of August one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four the Rights to be made at any time after the said Benjamin Hilgore clears the same through the Office & pays all fees that may be thereon Provided the same is laid on vacant Land

Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Mosley of the State and County aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me paid by John Machen have granted Bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant Bargain and sell and release unto the said John Machen all that plantation or Tract of Land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid and on the waters of Saluda River Consisting of one hundred and fifty acres the same more or less being a part of the the tract of Land whereon the said Mosley now lives from the Right of Jesse Hollin and Conveyed by said Hollin to Mosley the 18th January 1800 - Beginning on the upper line of the said Tract at the lower fence of a long ground field thence running on said fence to a hickory the first mark on said line thence a direct course to the Out line of said Land thence bounded on . May I do it John Jones Joseph Wood thence on a narrow line to the River thence on the meanders of the River to the beginning Together with all and the above mentioned premises to have and to hold to the said John Machen his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same from any self my heirs and assigns and from every person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness my hand this 22th of Jan^y 1800
