399 The following Deed of Conveyance from William Roe to George Gilbreath being proven before John Thomas Esq^r of the oath of George Robert Carter was presented and recorded this 8th day May 1800

This indenture made this 22nd day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two Between William Roe of Greenville District & State of S^c Carolina of the one part & George Gilbreath of the County and State of the other part witnesseth that he the said William Roe for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to him in hand paid the Receipt and payment whereof both here by acknowledge hath given granted and sold & by these presents doth give Grant Sell and confirm unto said George Gilbreath a certain plantation or tract of Land containing Thirty nine acres it being part of a certain tract of Land granted from His Office to John Childress and Obeliah Hooper which said Tract of thirty nine acres of Land being situate in the County of Greenville and lying on a branch of S^c Tygar river known by the name of Childresses Beaver dam beginning on a poplar on the west side of S^d Beaver dam at the mouth of a branch thence up the meanders of said creek to Childresses old mill from Sparkes line thence along S^c line S^o 115^o Degrees west 19 Chains 30 Links to a maple thence S^o 29 Degrees west 19 Chains 30 Links to a pine Stake thence to the beginning poplar together with all woods waters mines minerals hereditaments and appurtenances

South Carolina I know all men by these presents that Edward Nelson of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for an In consideration of the sum of Forty Dollars to me in hand paid by Lewis Green of the State & County aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge I do hereby Grant bargain sell alien release convey & confirm unto the said Lewis Green a plantation or parcel of land containing Twenty acres more or less being part of a tract of two hundred & Twenty acres more or less being part of a tract of Two hundred and Twenty acres conveyed to me by William Whaley by a deed dated the sixth day of August A^d 1798 bounded by Matthew Sparks Elias Wrights Kelleys Roes & the said Edward Nelson by a conditional marked line - To have and to hold the said twenty acres more or less, of land, with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Lewis Green his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Edward Nelson his heirs Executors and administrators unto the said Lewis Green his heirs and assigns &c. and from all and every other person or persons what soever
