Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Camp of Greenville County in the state aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Arnold of the state and County aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell & Release unto the said Benjamin Arnold a plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and Twenty four acres be the same more or less Situate in Greenville County lying on Horse Creek Beginning on a post Oak 3x on Thomas Camps Running thence S. 74 N. 35 E. 6 1/2 long said Camps to a Sweet Gum 3x near Horse Creek thence down the said Creek Granting to the said Benjamin Arnold 50 Lk from water mark on each side of said Creek to the mouth of a branch thence up the meanders of said Branch to Benjamin Arnolds line thence L. 31 on said Arnolds & Harveys Mullins line lines to stake 3x on the ancient boundary line thence N. 44 E. 44-72 on said old Indian line to a Pine 6x thence S. 29 W. 17-30 on William Williams line to the Beginning (being part of a Tract of 149 acres of Land Originally Granted to Samuel Farrance on the sixth day of April Anno Domini 1789 as p^o Grant Recorded in the Surveyors office in Grant Book I & I page 243) Together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and apputenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or apputaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Arnold his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin Arnold to him his heirs & assigns against my self and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the twenty fourth year of the Independancy of the united States of America Witness
