 being proven before John Young Esq^r by the oath of William Thurston Junr
 was presented and recorded this 28th day of July 1800 459

This Indenture made this Eighth of August in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight Between John Latham of the
 County of Greenville and State of S^c Carolina of the one part and William
 Thurston of the County and State aforesaid of the part witnesseth that the said
 John Latham for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds
 Sterling Money of S^c Carolina to him in hand paid before the sealing and deliv-
 ery of these presents by him the said William Thurston the Receipt whereof
 the said John Latham Doth hereby acknowledge him self thence with full
 satisfaction and of every part and parts thereof Doth hereby acquit and discharge
 the said William Thurston and his heirs forever hath granted Bargained sold
 and conveyed and by these presents Doth fully Clearly and absolutely Grant
 bargain sell and convey to him the said William Thurston his heirs and assigns
 forever a certain Piece or parcel of Land in the County and State aforesaid
 Beginning at a Post oak Corner in William Thackers line said Thurstons
 line running with said Thurstons line to Charles Bensons line at the main
 road thence with said Road to a post oak in William Mastins line thence with
 said line to a spanish oak at the path leading from said Mastins to Abram
 Bradlys Keeping said path to the top of a high hill in Bradlys old line
 thence with said line to a red oak Corner near a branch thence with
 said line Crossing two branches to a Red oak in William Thackers line
 thence with said Thackers line to the Beginning including two hundred and
 to the same more or less to have and to hold forever the said Granted and Bar-
 gain^d premises with all the appurtenances and pre-erogatives thereunto belonging
 or in anywise appertaining to him the said William Thurston his heirs and
 assigns forever to his and there only use forever and the said John Latham
