to William M'Clamhan being proven before Thomas Edwards
Esquire by the oath of Polly Earle was presented and
recorded this 3rd day of October 1800

State of South Carolina
Greenville District — I know all men by these
Presents that John Robinson of the County aforesaid
for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty
Dollars to me in hand paid by William M'Clamhan of the
same County and State have granted bargained sold
and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said William M'Clamhan
One hundred and seven acres of Land lying and being in
Greenville County aforesaid known as a branch known by
the name of the long branch emptying into Ruddy River to
being part of a tract of Land formerly in the Possession
of John Ford and by Conveyed to John Robinson partly
to these presents Beginning at a Stake and running
thence East 5 Chain to a Post Oak thence South 48 East
46 Chain to a post Oak thence S^o 25^o W 12 to a Post Oak
thence S^o 40^o E 15 to a Red Oak thence S^o 41^o W 23 to a
Stake in Long Branch thence up the Meanders of said Branch
to the beginning Together with all and singular
the Rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances
