

8 The Following Deed of Conveyance from James Thompson  
to John Clement being proven before Humphry Cobb Esq.  
by the oath of James McElroy was presented and recorded  
this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1800

This Indenture made this twentieth day of November  
One thousand seven hundred and eighty five Between  
James Thompson of South Carolina and Greenville County  
of the one Part and John Clement of the State aforesaid  
and the County of Inmatton of the other Part Witnesseth  
that the said James Thompson for an in consideration of  
the sum of three hundred and Forty Silver to him in hand  
Paid by the said John Clement at and before the sealing  
and delivery of the Rights the Receipts here by Acknow-  
ledged and he the said James Thompson hath Granted  
Bargained and sold all and Feoff<sup>com</sup> and firm and by these  
Presents doth give grant bargain sell all in full  
Release and Confirm unto the said John Clement his  
heirs and assigns One Certain Tract or Parcel of Land  
situated lying and being in Washington District  
and Greenville County on the North side of Saluda  
River containing Two hundred and nine acres it being  
to be a tract of Two hundred and nine acres granted  
to James Moore by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq.  
Governor of the aforesaid State granted and dated the third  
day of September One thousand seven hundred and eighty  
seven beginning at a Poplar on a branch of Saluda River  
thence running N. E. Eighty Chain and Seventy links  
to a Post on James McElroy's line thence along said line to  
a Post Oak Corner thence South Ten Degrees East twenty
