Know all men by these Presents that Daniel Symms of Pendleton County and State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred Mares to me paid in hand Hugh Roach of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do bargain sell and Release unto the said Hugh Roach all that tract of Land lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on both sides of the South fork of Bush Creek waters of Rudy River beginning on a Red oak a fallen cypress corner thence South 60 to a Red oak
