Parker to George Wigginton being proved before Hugh

Presented and Recorded this 18th November 1800

State of S Carolina - Know all men by these
presents that I Pleasant Parker of Greenville County
in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of One
hundred and Fifty dollars to me paid by George Wig-
ginton of the said County and State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released unto the
said George Wigginton all that tract or parcel of
Land lying situate in the state and county aforesaid
said on the branches of the North Saluda River
and on the south side of the said River contain-
ing One hundred and forty acres ~~thoroughly surveyed~~
for said Parker the Eighteenth of August in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
by George Salmon Esquire and has such Marks boundaries
and buttinss as a Plat and Grant represents which
Pl Grant is sign'd by his Excellency Charles Pinckney
Governor and commander in chief in and over the
said State the first day in January Anno Domini
one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight Together
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises before mentioned
to have and to hold all belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining to the said tract of Land before mention-
