 belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and  
 to hold all and singular the premises before men-  
 tioned unto the said Robert Embre his heirs & assigns  
 forever and I do hereby bind my self, my heirs Executors,  
 & administrators to warrant & forever defend with  
 singular the said premises unto the said Robert  
 Embre his Heirs and assigns against myself and  
 my heirs and against every person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
 thereof In witness whereof I have here unto set
