

120 The following deed of conveyance from William Vincent  
to Martin Gollatham, being proven before Hudson  
Goby Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Nelson Rogers was  
presented and Recorded this 18<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1807  
This Indenture made this Twentieth day  
of July and in the year of Our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and ninety three and in the Eighteenth year  
of American Independence between William  
Vincent of the One part and Martin Gollatham  
Planter of the other parts both of the State of  
South Carolina and County of Greenville witnesseth  
the said William Vincent for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twenty five pounds Sterling money  
to him in hand paid by the said Martin Gollatham  
and before the sealing and delivering of these presents  
the receipt whereof he the said William Vincent doth  
here by acknowledge and from every part and parcel  
thereof do acquit and discharge the said Martin  
Gollatham his Heirs and assigns and for divers other  
good causes and consideration hereunto moving  
have granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and  
confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain  
Enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Martin Golla  
tham his heirs and assigns for ever a parcel or a parts  
of a tract of Land lying in the County of Greenville  
on the little Puddy fork of Puddy river Originally  
Granted to Drury Smith on the fifth day of June 1786  
as by a plat thereunto annexed will fully appear
