

The Following deed of Conveyance from Archibald Taylor to  
William Bullion being proven before Stephen C. Wood Esq;  
by the oath of John Bucknor was presented and Recorded  
this 25<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1807

State of S'Caro linea - Know all men by these presents  
that I Archibald Taylor of Granville District S'Caro  
line in consideration of Four hundred and fifty seven  
Dollars to me paid by William Bullion of District  
and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold &  
released unto the said William Bullion a tract of  
Land containing four hundred acres more or less  
situated on the south branch of Muske Creek Tyrann  
Granville District on the south bordering by Mulle Mill  
le's land on the west by Mr Tubb's land on the E by  
Tubb's and Thomas Wols tract land located back corner  
of the bl thence on said Tract line 85° & 5° S<sup>o</sup> to the  
road thence with the said road sixty poles to a post  
 oak thence north by E<sup>o</sup> to a Hickory thence the same  
course to the Beginning together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident  
or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the said William  
Bullion his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby  
bind my self, my heirs Executors administrators to  
warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
said premises unto the said William Bullion his heirs and  
assigns against my self, my heirs & assigns and every
