Carter being proven before John Thomas Justice by the oath of
Wm D Thomas was presented and recorded this 10th day of March 1801
State of S^t Carolina — Know all men by these presents
that I Henry Pearson of the state and District aforesaid
and in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars
to me in hand paid by Robert Carter of the said District
the said Henry Pearson have granted bargained sold &
released and by these presents do grant & bargain sell and
release unto the said Robert Carter all that tract
plantation and parcel of land containing Two hundred
acres situate on Childress beaver dam a branch of south
fork of Tygar River beginning on a pine tree at 6^{ft}
50 chains to a white oak tree 8^{ft} 8ⁱⁿ tall 40 chains to a
red oak chimney tree there about 6^{ft} with the
mark^d lim to a spring branch running out of the land
thence to a stake on the bank of Beaver dam creek this line
