

214 The following deed of Conveyance from Jesse Suggs to
Dudley Howel being proven before David Goddett Esquire
by the oath of John Watson was presented and recorded
this 16th day of June 1807

This Indenture made this 2nd day of December one thou-
sand seven hundred and ninety nine, and of the Independ-
dency of the united States of America the twenty third
Between Jesse Suggs of the state of Carolina, &
County of Greenville of the one part & Dudley Howel
of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesses
for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five pounds
Sterling lawful money of said State in hand paid by
Dudley Howel hath bargained and sold & by these
presents doth bargain sell and make over unto Dudley
Howel a certain plantation or tract of land lying
in Greenville County on the head branches of Rudy
River with land creek which Jesse Suggs now lives on &
hath such boundaries when as it begins on Black
Sack corner running thence $N 80^{\circ} E 13$ Ch to a conditional
Spanish Oak corner thence $N 41^{\circ} 50$ to a stake corner
thence $S 75^{\circ} W 15$ Ch to a post Oak corner thence $S 72^{\circ} W$
 18 to a black Oak corner thence $S 5^{\circ} 48 1/2$ to Plum corner
thence $S 72^{\circ} W 10$ Ch to a stake corner thence $S 65^{\circ} W$ to a
conditional Black Sack corner thence to a conditional
Black Sack corner Ward on the line thence $S 68^{\circ} 8$ to
a post Oak corner thence $S 70^{\circ} E 5-25$ to a stake corner
from thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract
of land containing eight hundred & forty acres granted
unto Archabald Fowler from under the hand of his
excellency William Moultrie Esquire bearing date the
fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred ninety three
