






276 I Sarah Holland of the State of Carolina & District of

 piece of land lying and being in Greenville District
 in the forks between Enoree river & Mountain Creek
 beginning on the west side of Enoree on a Spanish Oak
 and running running with Russells line to a chestnut tree
 on the branch of Mountain Creek then down the creek to
 mouth then up the river to the first station the same
 containing ten acres or there same more or less with all
 and every of its appertinances the said John Holland
 and Sarah Holland doth from themselves and their
 heirs & from all and every other person and persons
 will warrant and forever defend to the said Adam
 Elrod his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof
 the said John Holland & Sarah Holland both here
 set their hands & seals the 21st day of Feb^r 1807
