This Indenture made the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 1808.

Between Gibson Southern of the State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina  
 and District of Greenville of the one part & Adam Elrod  
 of the same state and district of the other part Witnesseth that  
 the said Gibson Southern for and in consideration of the  
 sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the  
 said Adam Elrod (the receipt and payment  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged) he the said Gibson  
 Southern hath bargained and sold and by this presents  
 doth bargain and sell unto the said Adam Elrod  
 a certain tract or piece of land containing thirty  
 acres be the same more or less being part of a tract  
 of land originally granted to Mark Corner  
 beginning at said corner beginning corner and  
 running on his line to a black oak Paradwells corner  
 thence a conditional line to a stake on the branch  
 on Benjamin Brouces line thence down the branch  
 to the river Corners line thence with Corners line  
 to the beginning corner which said tract of land of  
 thirty acres be the same more or less with all and  
 every of its appertinences the s<sup>d</sup> Gibson Southern  
 doth from himself and his heirs and from all and  
 every other person or persons will warrant & forever  
 defend to the said Adam Elrod his heirs &  
 assigns forever in witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Gibson  
 Southern hath hereunto set his hand and affix  
 his seal the day and year above written
