

297 The following deed of Conveyance from John & Elizabeth Simmons
to La Simmons being proven before Tho^s Ferguson Esq^r by the
Cath^o John Simmons was presented and recorded this 6th Oct^r 1807
Know all men by these presents that we John Simmons and
Elizabeth Simmons of the State of South Carolina and District
of Greenville have this sixteenth day of Feb^r 1807 and in the
Independence of the United States the 26th have for and
in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to us in
hand paid by James Simmons of the state & District afore-
said have granted bargained & firmly sold confirm^d and
fully released hereby unto the said James Simmons all that
tract or parcel of land whereon the said John Simmons
now lives it being 1/4 of a tract originally granted to the
Usury & part of a tract originally granted to Busch Ben-
son containing one hundred acres be the same more or less
