Carolina, Greenville District, Aaron Evans personally came before me & made oath that he saw present & did see the within named Solomon Stone & Ebenezer Rice sign seal and as their act & deed deliver the within deed of Conveyance to Tho. Wood for the use & purpose within mentioned and that William Tully together with this deponent signed their names as witnesses to the same in presence of each other, Sworn to the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1801. This Indenture made the 9<sup>th</sup> of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine between John Forist of the State of S. Carolina and Greenville County of the one part, & Leonard Clay borne of the other part and State aforesaid. Witnesseth that the said John Forist for and in Consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath bargained granted & sold and by these presents doth bargain grant sell & confirm unto the sd Leonard Clay borne a certain Plantation or tract of Land containing or supposed to be one hundred acres, it being part of a tract of Land granted from State office to sd Forist bearing date one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven lying and being in Spartanburgh County & State aforesaid and situate on a branch of Little Bush Creek, beginning at a Pine running thence S 60 W to a red oak, thence N 45 W 50 to a red oak - thence N 45 E 15 to a red oak, thence N 70 E to a red oak corner a Conditional line made between Hutchins Forist and Mark Forist, & from thence following the sd Conditional line to the beginning - Together with all Wood, waters mines Mineral, Invention and
