

(The State of South Carolina). Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Stokes of Greenville District in consideration of Six hundred dollars to me in hand already paid by Elias Carle of the same place, Have granted been gained, sold and released and by these presents DO grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elias Carle all that part of a Tract of Land supposed to contain two hundred acres be the same more or less Situate in the District aforesaid on Tuckland Creek & waters thereof beginning at a Black Oak an Original corner of John Timmons & James Chichey thence South Eburne & Westbranch where an old path crosses thence with the Meanders of said Branch on East, & by course to the back line of the Original Survey (adjoining a 200 Acre Tract which was granted to Wm. Mason) thence

North 45 East to a chestnut in the Edge of Richland Creek near Alex. Waddles Saw-Mill, thence N. W. corner of Pitchey's ^{de Corner} the beginning being part of a Tract of Three Hundred & 13 Acre Originally granted to John Timmons & conveyed from said Timmons to me by deed bearing date the 23 day September 1796 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elias Carle his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Elias Carle his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs & against every other

Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal this thirteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred three and 1/2 of American Independence Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of Archibous Anderson William Edmond & Nathaniel Stokes
