 That I John Chapman of Greenville District, and State aforesaid
 in Consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand
 paid by John H. Harrison of the said State & District, have gra-
 ced bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said John H. Harrison a Tract
 of Land containing One hundred and three acres to the same
 more or less, situate in the District aforesaid On Reedy River
 beginning on a Beach 3+ on said River, running thence E^c 25^M 10'
 on James Kelly's line to Rock 3+ thence North 17-20 on Chandler
 line to a Red Oak 3+ thence West 60, to a Beach on Reedy River
 thence down said River with its meanders to the begining
 being part of a Tract of 640 acres originally granted to John
 Winn on the 10th day of July 1784. Recorded in Grant Book
 A A A page 57.) Together with all & singular the Rights mem-
 bers hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises be-
 longing or in any wise Incident or appertaining, to have
 & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said John H. Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do
 hereby bind myself my heirs &c as adm^{rs} to warrant & for ever
 defend the said premises unto the said John H. Harrison his
 heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns & against
 every other person whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or
 any part thereof - Witness my hand and Seal this twenty
 fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and one - SIGNED Sealed & delivered
