by these presents that I Augustin Sims of this State & District
of our said in consideration of Twenty five dollars to me paid
by Absolom Johnson of the State and District of our said, have
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Absolom
Johnson part of a tract of land that was granted to S. Sims
by a Grant bearing date the 3^d day of December 1792, recorded
in Grant book F N^o 5 page 375. It being the S. E. part of
said tract begining on a Spanish Oak a corner of the
Original tract rising N 35 W. to the Reedy fork the Dog
wood then up the Meanders of said Reedy fork to the mouth of the
Second branch being called the Long-branch, then up the
Meanders of said branch to an Ash on the back line of
the old tract thence S 80 E. to a Spanish Oak corner of
the old tract thence N 13 E 14^{or} to a Red Oak old corner,
thence a few degrees East the old line to a post oak thence
N. 50 E. 34^{or} to the begining, supposed to be Sixty acres
more or less. Situate in the District of our said on the
Waters of the Reedy fork of Reedy River. Together with all &
singular the Rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Absolom Johnson his heirs and
