Horatia Griffin & C. to the S. James Gough & his heirs for ever in witness whereof the said J. Gough hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written

E. side of the North East, Nancy & Dicy Southern on the West, a tract of land formerly belonging to Doctor Hodgeson on the S. W. Lying in the State and County aforesaid on Goose Creek. Together with all & singular the rights members incidents and appurtenances to the S. Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining or incident; to have & to see & singular the premises before mentioned unto the S. Israel Charles his heirs & assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself heirs & assigns & assigns to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the S. Premises unto the S. Israel Charles his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs & assigns every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand & seal this twenty fourth day of October in the Year of our one thousand eight hundred & in the twenty fourth Year of the Independence of the United States of America -
