Containing by estimation One hundred Acres be the same more or less, the same being the lower end of a Tract granted by patent bearing date March 1st 1790. to Robert Goodgion" and by him conveyed to William Wood and by him to Vincent Anderson and by him to John Robuck & by him to me. Together with all and singular the rights members hereafterments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Merrick Harrington his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & adm^{rs} to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Merrick Harrington his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
