Know all men by these Presents that William Duncan of the State of Virginia & District of Greenville for the Consideration of the Sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Lewis Duncan of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these Presents do bargain sell and Release unto the said Lewis Duncan One hundred and One Acres of Land including the Plantation whereon John Padon now lives. be the same more or less being part of a Tract of Land originally granted to Joseph Nations the sixth of February 1786. Situate in the District of Greenville on the branches of Puddy River and Enoree River, beginning upon a Spanish Oak the Original Corner thence S 30 E. along the Original to a Stake, thence a Conditional line Eastwardly to a Stake in the Original line, thence the Original N. 20 E. to a Stake, the Original, thence the Original to the beginning; Together with all and singular the Rights members Inheritments and appurtenances. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lewis Duncan his heirs and assigns for ever. & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lewis Duncan his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs & assigns & every other Person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - As Witness therunto I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of December in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and one, & in the twenty Sixth Year of the Independence of the United States of America
