-dred dollars to me in hand paid by Wm. Wade of the
District of Greenville have granted bargained sold & cleared
and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the S^r. Wm
- Wade part of the Tract or parcel of Land Lying and being
in the District aforesaid on the North side of the North Fork
of Saluda River Bounded as followeth, to wit, Beginning at a
Gum Station on the Cedar Mountain, thence a direct Course to
the top of the Town House mole, from thence N. E Course to
Malins line thence along said line to Mill Creek, thence
up said, to a poplar corner on back line, thence along S.
line to the beginning gum, containing One hundred acres be the
same more or less. Being Granted to William Stringer by Pa-
-tent and Conveyed to the above mentioned Wm. Wade, together
with all and singular the rights & members hereditamentals & appurte-
-nances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise belonging or
appertaining thereunto. To have and to hold all and singular the premi-
-ses before mentioned unto the said Wm. Wade himself his heirs
& assigns forever. & I the S^r. William Stringer do hereby bind myself
my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant & defend all
& singular the said Premises unto the S^r. Wm. Wade his heirs & assigns
against myself my heirs & assigns & from all & every person or persons who
shall lay any lawful claim to the said Premises under me or any
