I know all men by these Presents that I Solomon West of Greenville District and State aforesaid for Vin Consideration of One thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander Montgomery of Spartanburgh District & State aforesaid, Have granted bargained & sold and by these Presents Do grant bargain sell and release unto Alexander Montgomery a Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the District aforesaid, and on Muckles branch a branch of Needy River Containing two hundred acres more or less, bounded as followeth, Beginning at a Stake in the old line a corner of John Wests land thence S 20, W 11 Ch. & 80 links to a post oak, thence S 40, E 61 Chs. to a Stake in the old line, thence S. on M. Clanchans line to a Red Oak 3 Chs 25 links thence West on said M. Clanchans line to John Wests line to a post oak 60 Chs. thence N. on Hugh M. Veys 50 Chs. to a Hickory thence to the beginning. Containing two hundred acres more or less. (which land was granted to Thomas Wood by his Excellency William Moultrie bearing date the second day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty five) Together with all singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or
