## State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina.

I know all men by these Presents that I Samuel  
Earle of Greenville District and State aforesaid in considera-  
tion of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid  
by John Cantwell of the District and State aforesaid; have  
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant  
bargain & sell and release unto the said John Cantwell all  
that Tract or parcel of Land Situated in said District, on the  
waters of the main branch of N<sup>o</sup>. Fork Saluda beginning on a  
Poplar on a branch of Middle Saluda River, running thence  
N. 40 E. 74 " chains to a Poplar on a branch, thence up the branch to  
an other poplar " thence S. 74 E. 24 chains 50 links to a Stake thence  
N. 64 E. 6 chains 25 links to a White Oak, thence N. 7 W. 22 chains  
30 links to a Stake, thence N. 65. E. 3. ch. 10 links to a Chesnut thence  
N. 12. E. 9 chains 50 links to a Red Oak, thence N. 42. W. 5. 6 chains  
to a Red Oak, thence N. 81 W. 24 ch. 50 links to a light wood Stake  
thence S. 18. W. 9 ch. 6 links to a Red Oak, thence N. 88 E. 2 chains  
50 links to a pine stump, thence S. 47 W. 19 chains 20 links  
to a Chesnut Oak, thence S. 76 W. 12 Chain to the beginning -  
Computed to be one hundred and fifty five acres, be the same  
more or less - To have and to hold the said Land & Premises  
and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or  
appertaining unto the said John Cantwell his heirs and assigns for  
ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators  
& assigns to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid Land & premises  
unto the aforesaid John Cantwell his heirs executors administrators  
and assigns from the lawfull or just claim of any Person or
