at a White Oak running thence West 30 Ch. to a Red Oak, thence S 20 E 60.
Ch. to a Post Oak thence S 35 W 54 Ch. to a Stake, thence S 50 E 33.50.
to a Red Oak, thence N 65 E 70 Ch. to a Stake, thence N 15 W 52.10. from
thence a direct line to the beginning White Oak — Together with all
and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto
the said John Watson his heirs and assigns forever — And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever
defend all & singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Watson
his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other Person
