We the parties that James Lewis for & in consideration of the sum of three hundred & Seventy four and one quarter dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell alien releases and confirm unto John Shepherd for ever all that Tract Plantation or Parcel of Land containing two hundred & three & one quarter acres, a part of Langley & Sandys Lands, lying on the head of Peters Creek, the waters of <sup>Eocene</sup> Ashley River, the said land is bounded by Samuel Lewis' land Isaac Towses land & Austin Smith's land & John Shepherd's land & James Gooches land, and the said James Lewis doth Covenant and agree to and with the said John Shepherd that the above described Tract of land is free from any manner of encumbrance whatsoever, and he the said James Lewis will for ever warrant & defend the said tract or Plantation of "land" from all person or persons having any Right Title or claim therewards, and all and every part thereof from himself his heirs executors Administrators or assigns or any other person or persons what so ever laying just or lawful right title or claim therewards, But to the proper use of the said John Shepherd his heirs Executors or Administrators or assigns for ever.
