Gooch of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration  
of Twenty pounds to me in hand paid by John Shepherd of the State of South  
Carolina Lander County, I the said James Gooch have granted bargained  
sold & released and by these Presents Do grant bargain sell and release  
unto John Shepherd all that Tract or parcel of land containing One  
hundred and eighty five acres, situated in Greenville County & State  
of foreaid, the same being originally granted to the said James Gooch  
by Patent bearing date in One thousand seven hundred and ninety  
nine & including the Plantation whereon James Gooch now lies, &  
the School house Blanks is the dividing line from the mouth of it to a post  
oak on the old line about twenty rods from the Creek, and every  
other part of said land being described by a Plat annexed to the said  
Grant. Together with all & singular the above described Purviance, Right  
numbers hereditaments there unto belonging or in any wise appertaining  
thereto to have and to hold all and singular the Purviances before men-  
tioned unto the said John Shepherd his heirs and assigns for ever, & I  
do hereby bind myself & heirs executors & administrators to warrant & defend  
funds all and singular the said Purviances, unto the said John Shepherd his  
heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every other person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. —  
Witness my hand and seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord  
One thousand seven hundred & ninety nine, & in the twenty fourth year  
of the Independence of the United States of America
