of Enoree river, Recorded in Greer's Distict in Book D. page 297 & 298.
Beginning on a Sappasat, Conditional Corner, running South on Yards
line to a Post Oak Corner, thence West to a Corner on a Post Oak, thence N.
across said Creek to where said line crosses the branch that Thomas Watson
formerly lived on thence down said Branch to said Creek, thence down
said Creek to the Shoal together with a sufficient quantity of ground for
