


bargain grant and sell unto the said Benjamin Holley, a certain Tract

bearing N 55 W 44 to a Red oak thence N 60 W 20 to a Chestnut oak,  
thence N 40 W 17 to a White oak, thence N 30 E 24 to a red oak, thence  
N 75 E 17 50 to a poplar, thence to the beginning corner to the above S. Benja-  
min Holley his heirs & assigns. To have and to hold the above said land & premises  
with all wood, waters houses orchards gardens with every thing belonging  
or in any wise appertaining therunto from the above S. James Nicholl his  
heirs & assigns for ever. & from all and every other Person or  
Persons from having or laying any just right title or claim there unto

consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars current money of the  
State aforesaid to him in hand paid by the said James Ross at & before  
the sealing and signing of these Presents the receipt and payment whereof  
is hereby acknowledged, that the said John Burk for himself and his heirs  
doth hereby ~~bargain and~~ bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him  
the said James Ross his heirs executors & administrators forever, a  
certain parcel of land in the said District of Greenville  
Situate, lying and being as follows, on the Waters of Fortinberry's  
Beaver-dam, middle of <sup>99</sup> or River above the Indian Boundary line  
Containing Three hundred and Twenty nine acres [in the same manner]  
Beginning at a Stake on said Beaver-dam thence S. 38° 50' to a Stake
