

His heirs and assigns forever part of four original Tracts of land lying in the  
 State and District aforesaid on Reedy River & the waters thereof. first a Tract originally  
 granted to Thomas Jenkins for 640 acres and signed by Gov<sup>r</sup> Gurnard on  
 the 15<sup>th</sup> Oct<sup>r</sup> 1784. All that part of s<sup>t</sup> Tract lying on the North E. side  
 of Reedy River, begining on the lower Square where the original line crosses  
 the River, thence S.E. 66° thirty chains to a Dogwood, the original corner, thence  
 N.E. 24° Eighty chains to a Red Oak, the original corner on an old road leading  
 from James Harrison's to Maj. John Alexander. thence N.W. 66° Eighty Eight  
 chains to a Stake on Land granted Gen<sup>r</sup> Rich<sup>d</sup> Winn, now possessed by the  
 said James Harrison, the original corner. thence S.W. 24° forty chains  
 to Reedy River, thence down the middle of said River with the meanders  
 to the begining — Also all that part of a Tract of Land granted originally  
 to Owen Jenkins for two hundred and fifty acres, & signed by Governor  
 Moultrie on the 4<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1786. all that part of said Tract of Land  
 lying on N.E. side of Reedy River — Also part of a Tract of land originally  
 granted to Micajah Jenkins on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785. for 640 acres  
 Beginning on the said Thomas Jenkins' original corner Reo oak on said  
 Road above mentioned, thence on said Thomas Jenkins' original line N.W. 66°  
 Eighty Eight chains to a Stake on James Harrison's line, thence on S. line N.E.  
 24° to a pine on the above mentioned old Road leading from James Harrison  
 to Maj. John Alexander thence in the middle of said Road to the begining  
 Red Oak corner. — Also all the residue or land possessed by James  
 Kelley lying on N.E. & S.E. side of Reedy River being part of two Tracts  
 one originally granted to John Winn, the other to William Choice.  
 Beginning on said River on a Beach corner on the said John H.  
 Harrison's line, thence along the said Harrison's line S.E. on lands  
 occupied by John Chapman, Solomon King Chandler & Wm. Choice  
 & Joseph Thompson to the said Reedy River, thence up said River  
 with the meanders to the begining, Containing in the whole by estimation  
 Eight hundred and fifty six acres, to the same more or less, as by  
 the plats grants and Conveyances restricting the same will more  
 fully appear. Together with all and singular the Rights members heredi-  
 tament and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise  
 Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the  
 Premises before mentioned unto unto the said James Harrison his heirs & assigns  
 forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators  
 to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the Premises unto the said  
 James Harrison his heirs & assigns, against myself and my heirs & against every  
 Person or Persons whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof  
 Witnessed and vsed this 25<sup>th</sup> day of January One thousand eight hundred & three — 1803
