

The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I Wellington Casley of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me paid by William Toney of Spartanburgh District in the State aforesaid, Have granted bargain sold and Release unto the said William Toney, all that Plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and seventy acres (more or less) Situate in Ninety Six District on Saluda River opposite the Confluence of Georges Creek, Bounding on said river and all other sides on Vacant land when first surveyed, & granted to James Clayton Beginning at a white Oak on said River, running N. 26 E 49.50 to a Stake corner, thence N. 70 W 42.50 to a white Oak on said River, thence down the meanders of said River to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Toney "against the claim of all persons whatsoever" in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th of December A.D. 1802.
