Presents that I William Killen of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid
in consideration of three hundred dollars to me paid by William Williams
of Greenville District and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and
released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said William Williams, All that Tract of Land Situate in the said
District of Greenville on the waters of Mountain Creek, branches of Saluda
River, originally granted to John Blackwell, and from Blackwell to
Wm Killen, four hundred and Seventy five acres by a grant bearing
date, the third day of March 1794. Recorded in Grant Book H.C. No. 5, page 174
Signed by Wm. Moultrie then Governor over S. State, Now from the S.
Blackwell to the S. Wm Killen, and from Killen to Wm Williams One
hundred and Seventy acres of S. Tract. Beginning at a Red Oak 3^x turning
N. 70° W 35° 50' to a post oak, thence S 30° E 2. 14. 40' to a Stake, thence S 40° E 66
ch. to a red oak, thence E 10° to a Stake, thence N 6 W 55 ch. to a Stake, thence
S 50 W 35° 50' to the begining including 170. acres. Together with all and
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the S. premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Williams
his heirs and Assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the
