hundred dollars to me paid by Willey S Brown of the district aforesaid  
have granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do  
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Willey S Brown a Plantation  
or Tract of land laying & being in the District aforesaid on both sides  
of South Pacolet River, at a Red Oak, in the fork of Green's Creek & the River  
about one Chain from the River P. W. S. Brown Corner running thence S 20 E.  
Crops the River to a Post Oak thence to a pine on David Hall's land thence  
N. 10 W. 11 ch. 50 links to a pine, thence N. 60 W. 7 chs. to Chestnut Oak  
thence N. 10 W. 19 chs. crops. the River to a Red Oak, thence N. 60 E. to a  
Stake S. Brown's line thence S 39 E. to a red Oak thence S 28 E. 15 chs.  
to a black Oak, thence S 39 E. to the begining Containing by estimation  
One hundred Acres, be the same more or less being a part of a Tract  
of land granted by patent to Joseph Maxwell bearing date 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of December 1791. and by him conveyed to John Huddleston and by him  
to William Laughlin Esq. & John his Son and by them to Isham Burke  
& by him to Richard Braseal, and by him to Nathaniel Gentry and  
by him to me, whereon is erected a Full Mill, Together with all  
and singular the Rights numbers hereditaments and appurtenances to  
the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining: To have and  
to hold all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the  
said W. S. Brown forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Executors and Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all Singular  
the said Premises unto the said Willey S. Brown his heirs and assigns  
against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal the twentieth day of December  
September in the year of Our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and two, and  
Twenty seventh year of American Independence
